Rosé PINOT NOIR



Vinos Folâtre is a family story. Lorena Folâtre named the winery in memory of her grandfather, Hermond Folâtre who arrived in Chile during the early last century, coming from his motherland France. He settled in the town of Pichaman, near Curicó, in the world-famous Maule Región. Folâtre wines are known at an international level for their exceptional quality.

Winemaking

Our Pinot Noir for Rosé is harvested at the same time as Pinot Noir for red wines. Following the same steps as for white winemaking, the grapes are directly pressed: the juice and the skin are not left in contact for a long period of time. We did use the same process as in the famous Loire Valley in France, the pinky juice is separated in two tanks; the first one is fermented and filtered as a traditional dry rosé, although the second one is exposed to precisely controlled low temperatures, in order to stop the alcoholic fermentation and to preserve the natural residual sugar.

Then, both wines are blended together to make our exceptionnal "Pinot Noir Sweet Rosé".

Tasting Notes

A juicy rosé, perfect to pair as an aperitive, with seafoods, spicy cuisine such as Thai and sushis.
