Winemaking

Light maceration at 5°C and alcoholic fermentation at 15°C for two weeks.

Tasting Notes

The nose develops tropical fruits such as pineapple and herbs. The mouth is fresh and balanced. The main flavours are tropical fruit and citrus. The finish in mouth is mineral, which is typical for our high altitude vineyards. Yellow colors with notes of bright green.

For drinking as an aperitive or pairing with seafood, sushi, salads.
