Pichaman, the name of an old terminal train station. Its name comes from the Mapudungun language used by natives and means “Little condor”. The Folâtre Family, of French origin, first came to this area by train, where they settled after seeing the stunning land and its possibility to cultivate grapes, a wine making tradition since then....

Winemaking

Pre fermentative maceration for 7 days at 8°C, Fermentation at 28°C, post fermentation maceration for 10 days.

Tasting Notes

A deep red wine with garnet color. The nose is tasty and develops notes of red fruits. The mouth is balanced with bold tannins, and shows red fruits and spices. Elegant and well structured.

Perfect to pair with red meat and cheeses.
